
#### 1. Basic Information






#### 4. Distribution of Editorial Board Members






#### 5. Number of Published Articles (results by year)

#### 6. Diverse Types of Article Published in 2016




In 2016, APM has published 48 manuscripts, among which there are 25 review articles and original articles.

Other article types include Correspondence, Meeting report, Mini review, Systematic review and meta-analysis, Technical Note, etc.




# 7. International Diversity of Corresponding Authors in 2016


